YEAR-END GIVING

Getting ready for your year-end giving? Here are some things to keep in mind when making your charitable plans:

- Beginning in 2026, for taxpayers who itemize, their charitable gifts must exceed 0.5% of AGI before they qualify for deduction. There is no "floor" for the 2025 tax year, so it might be more beneficial to give sooner rather than later.
- Mailed donations must be postmarked by December 31, 2025.
- You can donate to KACF directly from your Individual Retirement Account! Ask your financial advisor to find out how to make the biggest impact and possibly save on taxes.
- Making a stock contribution can be beneficial, especially if you've held the stock for more than a year and its value has increased by the time you donate it. You can deduct the stock's full market value without worrying about capital gains.
- Our annual giving day is a great opportunity to make year-end donations and support giving in our community. On December 4, donate during Give Where You Live! Or call Judi at (308) 237-3114 for ideas of unmet community needs.

Prefer to give online? Visit givewhereyoulive.net to make your donation. Early giving opens November 6. All online gifts made between November 6 and December 3 will be processed immediately and qualify for the match and prizes.

Making a gift from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) is a great way to support GWYL. Qualified Charitable Distributions from your IRA go directly to charity and are excluded from your taxable income. It provides an excellent opportunity to help local nonprofits and may lower your taxes. It's a win-win for both you and your community. Since gifts from an IRA, donor advised fund, appreciated stock or gift of grain can take some time, please call Angie at (308) 237-3114 to plan in advance.

Kearney Area Community Foundation's "Building for Tomorrow" fund recently awarded \$7,500 in grants to five local nonprofits.

 Crossroads Center Inc. received a grant for their Food Recovery Program, which provides meals and food boxes for those in need in the community.



• Kearney Community Sustainable Housing received a grant to help create a wraparound educational program for residents.



- Kearney Public Schools Foundation received a grant for music and music holders to use during the Parade of Heroes Veterans Ceremony in Washington, D.C. and beyond.
- Nebraska Diaper Bank received a grant for supplemental diaper supplies for local families experiencing a need.
- Salvation Army received a grant for the Holiday Hunger Assistance program, which provides gift cards to families in need so they can prepare and enjoy a traditional holiday dinner together.




